ORDINANCE NO. A - 423

AN ORDINANCE MAKING LEFT TURNS AT CERTAIN INTERSECTIONS WITHIN THE CITY OF CONWAY, ARKANSAS UNLAWFUL: DECLARING AN EMERGENCY: AND FOR OTHER REASONS

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Conway, Arkansas acting by and through its traffic committee has made a study of traffic congestion at certain intersections within the City of Conway, Arkansas; and

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Conway, Arkansas, after such study, did determine that vehicles making left turns at the following named intersections did contribute greatly to said traffic congestion; and

WHEREAS, it was decided by said City Council, based upon said study, that it would be to the best interest of the inhabitants of the City of Conway, Arkansas, and would greatly relieve the traffic congestion in said City if left-turns were made unlawful at certain intersections within said City:

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CONWAY, ARKANSAS:

SECTION 1. That on and after the passage of this ordinance it shall be unlawful for any person driving a vehicle within the City of Conway to make a left turn at the following named intersections, to-wit:

- 1. Intersection of Front and North Streets
- 2. Intersection of Oak and Chestnut Streets
- 3. Intersection of Oak and Court Streets
- 4. Intersection of Oak and Front Streets

Provided, however, that persons driving a vehicle East on Oak Street may make a left turn North onto Front Street.

SECTION 2, Any person violating the provisions of this ordinance shall be deemed guilty of a misdemeanor and upon conviction thereof shall be fined in any sum not less than Five Dollars (\$5.00), nor more than Twenty Five Dollars (\$25.00), for each such violation.

SECTION 3, All ordinances and parts of prdinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

SECTION 4. It is ascertained and declared that allowing left turns at the intersections aforementioned is endangering the health,

safety and well being of the inhabitants of the City of Conway; therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this ordinance, being necessary for the immediate preservation of the health, safety and welfare of the inhabitants of said City, shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and publication.
