

ORDINANCE NO. A - 504

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND SECTION 3 OF ORDINANCE NO. A-396 OF THE CITY OF CONWAY, ARKANSAS AS AMENDED BY ORDINANCE NO. A-497 OF THE CITY OF CONWAY, ARKANSAS; DECLARING AN EMERGENCY; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CONWAY, ARKANSAS:

SECTION 1. That Section 3 of Ordinance No. A-396 of the City of Conway, Arkansas, adopted April 11, 1963, as amended by Section 2 of Ordinance No. A-497 of the City of Conway adopted June 12, 1970,<sup>be</sup> and the same is hereby amended to read as follows:

"Section 3. The Chairman shall preside over all meetings of the Commission but in his absence the Vice-Chairman shall preside. The Secretary-Treasurer shall keep true and complete written records of all proceedings of the Commission and transmit its recommendations to the City Council; he shall further be the custodian of all funds of the Commission, which shall be deposited in a bank or banks whose funds are insured by the Federal Deposit Insurance Corporation. All disbursements of funds shall be upon written order or check signed by the Chairman or Secretary-Treasurer of the Commission and the Mayor of the City of Conway. All accounts payable by said Commission shall be submitted to the City Council for approval and allowance in the same manner as the accounts of other departments of the City are approved and allowed. In addition thereto the Commission shall prepare and submit to the Mayor and City Council, on or before December 31 of each year, a budget for the year immediately ensuing!"

SECTION 2. It is necessary to the health and welfare of the citizens of the City of Conway that this ordinance be immediately effective and an emergency is therefore declared to exist and this ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and publication.
