

ORDINANCE NO. A-573

AN ORDINANCE **REZONING** CERTAIN PROPERTY WITHIN
THE CITY OF CONWAY, ARKANSAS: DECLARING AN
EMERGENCY: AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

WHEREAS, the Planning Commission of the City of Conway, Arkansas, did on the 18th day of June, 1973, conduct a public hearing for the purpose of determining the necessity for rezoning certain property within said City, said hearing having been held following proper call and notice thereof for the time and in the manner required by law; and,

WHEREAS, it was determined at such hearing that said property should be rezoned as hereinafter set forth:

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CONWAY, ARKANSAS:

SECTION ONE (1). The zoning classification of the hereinafter described property within the City of Conway, Arkansas, having been heretofore zoned as "R-2, Two-Family Residential District", is hereby amended so as to rezone same as "R-3, Multiple-Family Residential District", together with all the rights and privileges pertaining to such zoning classification, to-wit:

Lots Ten (10), Eleven (11), Twelve (12), Thirteen (13), Fourteen (14), Fifteen (15), Block Sixty-three (63), Boulevard Addition, City of Conway, Arkansas,

SECTION TWO (2). This ordinance being necessary for the public safety and welfare, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this ordinance shall be in force and shall take effect from and after its passage and publication.
