

ORDINANCE NO. 0-76- 19

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING PART B, SECTION 2, OF SECTION 10-20- PART 4 OF ORDINANCE A-523: DECLARING AN EMERGENCY, AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES:

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF CONWAY, ARKANSAS:

SECTION 1: That Part B, of Section 2, of Section 10-20- 4 of Ordinance A-523, is hereby amended to read as follows:

That a conditional use permit issued under this ordinance is an In Personam use or permit and not an In Rem permit and can not be transferred from one person to another, but can only be used by the person in whose name the permit was issued.


That if a person in whose name the permit was issued does not for any reason place a mobile home in the location designated in the permit for 30 days or allows for any reason the property designated in the permit to remain vacant for 30 days, then the permit shall automatically become null and void after that time.

That there will be a fee charged of \$ 10.00 for each permit.


SECTION 2: It being necessary for the protection of the public an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this ordinance shall take effect immediately upon and after its passage.
