

AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING ONE-WAY TRAFFIC ON CERTAIN STREETS IN THE CITY OF CONWAY, ARKANSAS; DECLARING AN EMERGENCY AND FOR ALL OTHER PURPOSES.

WHEREAS, because of the increase traffic flow in and around the grammar schools located on Harkrider Street, South Boulevard, and Donaghey Avenue in the City of Conway, Arkansas it has become necessary to establish one-way traffic in and around those streets during school hours, and,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CONWAY, ARKANSAS:

Section 1: That Fourth Street, from the intersection of Fourth and Factory Street to the intersection of Fourth and Harkrider Street is to be a one-way street going west from 8:00 a.m. until 9:00 a.m., and from 3:00 p.m. until 4:00 p.m. Monday through Friday during the months the schools are in session.

Section 2: That South Boulevard from the intersection of South Boulevard and Davis Street to the intersection of South Boulevard and Center Street is to be a one-way street going east from 8:00 a.m., until 9:00 a.m. and from 3:00p.m. until 4:00 p.m., Monday through Friday during the months the schools are in session.

Section 3: That Poplar Street is to be a one-way street going east from 8:00 a.m. until 9:00 a.m. and from 3:00 p.m. until 4:00 p.m. , Monday through Friday during the months the schools are in session.


Section 4: That Lee Street from the intersection of Lee Street and Eastfield Street to the intersection of Lee Street and Dongahey Avenue is to be a one-way street going east from 8:00 a.m. until 9:00 a.m. and from 3:00 p.m. until 4:00 p.m., Monday through Friday during the months the schools are in session.

Section 5: It being necessary for the protection of the public an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this

ordinance shall take effect immediately upon and after its passage.


