

ORDINANCE NO. 0-85-29

AN ORDINANCE RELATING TO ATTACHING WOOD FRAME WALLS TO FOUNDATIONS, AMENDING CHAPTER 11.16, SECTION 11.16.06 OF THE CONWAY MUNICIPAL CODE; DECLARING AN EMERGENCY AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES:

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CONWAY, ARKANSAS:

SECTION 1: That Chapter 11.16, Section 11.16.06 of the Conway Municipal Code be hereby amended to add "E" which shall read as follows:

"E. A powder actuated fastening system may be used to fasten the sill of a wood framing system to the foundation in place of one-half inch round bolts at six feet on center if the following criteria are met:


1. The user of the powder actuated fastening system shall comply with powder-actuated fastening systems safety requirements.
2. A manufacturer's recommendations, especially regarding spacing and fastener type, shall be followed.
3. The manufacturer's recommendations shall be submitted to the City Inspector by the user prior to use."

SECTION 2: That all ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed to the extent of that conflict.

SECTION 3: That this ordinance being necessary for the public peace and welfare there is hereby declared an emergency to exist and this ordinance shall become effective upon its passage and publication.


