

ORDINANCE NO. 0-98- 125

**AN ORDINANCE ACCEPTING THE ANNEXATION OF
CERTAIN LANDS TO THE CITY OF CONWAY, ARKANSAS;
DECLARING AN EMERGENCY;
AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES**

**NOW, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CONWAY,
ARKANSAS:**

SECTION 1: The City of Conway, Arkansas, hereby accepts the hereinafter described territory, annexed to said City by order of the County Court of Faulkner County, Arkansas, heretofore entered on the 2nd day of December, 1998, said territory being situated in Faulkner County, Arkansas, and described as follows:

Being a part of the NE1/4 SW1/4, Section 8, T-5-N, R-14-W, Faulkner County, Arkansas, described as beginning at the NE corner of said NE1/4 SW1/4; thence S-00-15-19-W along the East line of said NE1/4 SW1/4 1330.40 feet to the SE corner of said NE1/4 SW1/4; thence S-89-32-37-W along the South line 1319.36 feet to the SW corner of said NE1/4 SW1/4; thence N-00-12-53-E along the West line of said NE1/4 SW1/4 1122.03 feet; thence leaving the West line N-89-36-53-E 420.00 feet; thence N-00-12-53-W 210.00 feet to the North line of said NE1/4 SW1/4; thence N-89-36-531-E along the North line 900.28 feet to the point of beginning containing 38.31 acres more or less.

and that said above described lands and territory be, and the same hereby are, declared to be a part of the City of Conway, Faulkner County, Arkansas, and shall be zoned R-1.

SECTION 2: From and after this date, the inhabitants residing within and upon the hereinabove described lands and territory shall have and enjoy all the rights and privileges of, and be subject to all the laws, rules, ordinances, limitations, and regulations imposed upon the inhabitants within the original limits of said City of Conway, Arkansas, and for voting purposes, said lands are hereby assigned to and designated as a part of Ward 3 of the City of Conway, Arkansas.

SECTION 3: It is hereby ascertained and declared that it is necessary for the protection and preservation of the public health and safety that the foregoing ordinance be passed and adopted; that an emergency exists; that this ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and publication.
