ORDINANCE NO. 0-99-115

AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING TWO HOUR PARKING ZONES; PROVIDING PENALTIES FOR VIOLATIONS THEREOF; DECLARING AN EMERGENCY; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

WHEREAS, it is in the interests of the City of Conway to implement two hour parking areas in certain downtown areas in order to accommodate consumers and provide for the orderly flow of commercial traffic;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CONWAY, ARKANSAS,

SECTION 1. The street department is hereby authorized to determine the location of two-hour parking zones and to place and maintain appropriate signs and curb painting indicating the same and stating the hours during which said limitations are applicable, provided that the installation of such zones shall be subject to the following conditions:

- a. All so-called "two hour" zones heretofore designated and marked are designated as two-hour parking zones.
- b. No person shall park any vehicle in any two-hour parking zone located in the city for longer than two (2) hours at any time between the hours of 6:00 a.m. and 6:00 p.m. if the hours are not designated then not longer than two (2) hours at any time except on Sundays and holidays. All such two-hour parking zones shall be designated by signs and curb painting.

SECTION 2. The penalty for violations in "two hour" zone parking areas shall be \$5.00 if paid within twenty-one (21) days. After twenty-one (21) days, the fine will be \$25.00. A curb citation shall be provided in the issuance of a violation citation for the convenience of motorists.

SECTION 3. All citations written under this ordinance shall also clearly state a time and place at which a motorist may pay or contest the citation. Any tickets not paid within twenty-one (21) days or contested in municipal court shall be subject to all regular court costs as mandated by state law.

SECTION 4. This ordinance is necessary for the protection of the peace, health and safety of the citizens of Conway, and therefore, an emergency is declared to exist, and this ordinance shall go in effect from and after its passage and approval.
