## ORDINANCE NO. 0-01- /0ス

## AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 7.08.04 OF THE CONWAY MUNICIPAL CODE: REPEALING ANY ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT; DECLARING AN EMERGENCY; AND FOR **OTHER PURPOSES**

WHEREAS, Act 1262 of 2001 provides that juvenile court shall have concurrent jurisdiction with district court for juvenile curfew (ordinanceviolations; and

WHEREAS, the Mayor and City Council desire to amend Section 7.08.04 of the Conway

Municipal Code, which addresses penalties for violation of juvenile curfew violations;

## NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CONWAY, ARKANSAS, THAT:

SECTION 1. That Section 7.08.04 Penalty shall be amended to read as follows:

"7.08.04 Penalty. Any parent, guardian or other person having the legal care or custody of any person under the age of eighteen (18) years, and/or any minor person under the age of eighteen (18) years violating any of the provisions of this ordinance shall be deemed guilty of a misdemeanor and upon conviction thereof shall be fined up to Two Hundred Fifty Dollars (\$250.00) for the first offense, and for any subsequent conviction such minor person and/or parent, guardian or legal custodian of such minor person, shall be fined not less than Two Hundred Fifty Dollars (\$250.00) nor more than Five Hundred Dollars (\$500.00).

SECTION 2. That any ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed to the extent of that conflict.

SECTION 3. That this ordinance is necessary for the protection of the peace, health and safety of the citizens of Conway, and therefore, an emergency is declared to exist, and this ordinance shall go into effect from and after its passage and approval.
