AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 0-2001-64; CLARIFYING THE DEFINITION OF "INOPERABLE MOTOR VEHICLE"; REPEALING ANY ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT; DECLARING AN EMERGENCY; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

WHEREAS, the definition of "inoperable motor vehicle" in Ordinance No. 0-2001-64 inadvertently omitted language relating to vehicles without current license or registration, language that had been contained in the previous ordinance relating to junked or abandoned vehicles, Ordinance No. 0-00-20.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CONWAY, ARKANSAS, THAT:

Section 1. That Ordinance No. 0-2001-64, Section 1, as codified at Section 8.04.01 of the Conway Municipal Code is hereby amended to change the definition of "inoperable motor vehicles" as follows (changes are italicized):

"Inoperable motor vehicle means a motor vehicle, the condition of which is wrecked, dismantled, partially dismantled, incapable of operation by its own power upon a public street, or from which the wheels, engine, transmission or substantial part thereof has been removed, *or a motor vehicle with expired vehicle licenseplate or expired registration tabs.*"

Section 2: That any ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed to the extent of that conflict.

Section 3: That this ordinance is necessary for the protection of the peace, health and safety of the citizens of Conway, and therefore, an emergency is declared to exist, and this ordinance shall go into effect from and after its passage and approval.
