City of Conway, Arkansas Ordinance No. <u>0-08-119</u>

AN ORDINANCE APPROPRIATING REVENUE FUNDS TO THE CONWAY SANITATION DEPARTMENT, DECLARING AN EMERGENCY AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES:

WHEREAS, the City of Conway Sanitation Department has an immediate need to replace a Dozer purchased from Scott Equipment Company, after discovering the dozer from this company did not meet bid specifications; and

WHEREAS, Scott Construction Company will reimburse the City of Conway \$90,000 for the Dozer, which represents the original purchase price, less an agreed set-off for the City's use of the equipment;

WHEREAS, The Sanitation Department would like to purchase a Crawler Dozer from Warrior of Arkansas for \$157,850, the second lowest bid from previous bids submitted;

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CONWAY, ARKANSAS THAT:

SECTION 1. The Sanitation Department request approval to return the Dozer purchased from Scott Construction Company and accepts a refund of \$90,000.

SECTION 2. The City of Conway should accept the second lowest bid from Warrior of Arkansas, from bids submitted on Monday, July 23rd, 2007 in the amount of \$157,850.

SECTION 3. The City of Conway shall appropriate \$90,000 from Sanitation Replacement Fund Sale of Assets account (23.920) and \$67,850 from Sanitation Replacement Fund Balance Appropriation account (23.990) into Heavy Equipment (23.118.934).

SECTION 4. All ordinances in conflict herewith are repealed to the extent of the conflict.

SECTION 5. That this ordinance is necessary for the protection of the public peace, health, and safety, and an emergence is hereby declared to exist, and this ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and approval.
