

City of Conway, Arkansas Proclamation by: Mayor Bart Castleberry International Overdose Awareness Day August 31<sup>st</sup>, 2020

Whereas, International Overdose Awareness Day aims to raise awareness of overdose, reduce the stigma surrounding drug-related deaths and remember those who have died or suffered permanent injury due to drug overdose; and

**Whereas,** An overdose occurs when a drug (or combination of drugs), including prescription medications prescribed by a doctor, overwhelms the body; and

**Whereas,** According to the CDC (STATCAST-Week of September 9, 2019) over 770,000 Americans have died from drug overdoses since; and

Whereas, International Overdose Awareness Day spreads the message that the tragedy of overdose death is preventable; and

**Whereas,** Arkansas is the second leading state in prescribing opioid medicines with 66 of the state's 75 counties prescribing rates higher than the national average.

**NOW, THEREFORE, I, Bart Castleberry,** Mayor of the City of Conway, Arkansas do hereby proclaim Monday August 31<sup>st</sup>, 2020 as:

## "INTERNATIONAL OVERDOSE AWARENESS DAY"

I further encourage all citizens to support their local communities efforts to prevent the tragic effects of overdose and encourage and support the families who have been affected.
