WHEREAS, a fully developed and well maintained road and street system will improve Faulkner county and its municipalities economies; and

WHEREAS, roads and streets impact all aspects of economic activity including the expansion of existing business and industry, the successful recruitment of new industry, and the supply to and distribution of manufactured products; and

WHEREAS, roads and streets enhance the activity of tourism destinations, provide for scenic travel around the county, and enhance recreation opportunities through access to natural areas; and

WHEREAS, an improved "farm-to-market" road and street system aids in the maintenance and development of agricultural-based industries and industries which thrive on the county's and municipalities' natural resources; and

WHEREAS, current deficient and defective road and street conditions endanger public safety, cause unnecessary vehicle maintenance costs to consumers, restrict economic competitiveness and surrounding counties, and diminish the Faulkner County overall quality of life.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CONWAY, ARKANSAS, THAT we hereby encourage the political leadership of Faulkner County, the Quorum Court, to pass the necessary ordinances to allow the residents of Faulkner County to vote, at a special election, for or against the passage of a 1/2 cent sales tax, which will provide adequate funding for the construction and maintenance program.
