

City of Conway, Arkansas Resolution No. R-20-67

A RESOLUTION APPROVING A PROPOSAL TO PROVIDE ADAPTIVE SIGNAL CONTROL TECHNOLOGY FOR OAK STREET FOR THE CONWAY TRANSPORTATION DEPARTMENT; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES

Whereas, the City of Conway Transportation Department solicited proposals for the adaptive signal control technology on Oak Street; and

Whereas, two qualified proposals were received from Rhythm Traffic and Temple. Proposals were evaluated and Temple received the highest evaluation score; and

Whereas, the City would like to enter into an agreement with Temple to provide this stated technology for \$478,677; and

Whereas, \$600,000 was allocated to the City of Conway as a Federal-aid Surface Transportation Block Grant Program Attributable (STBGP GT 2000k) project grant for Oak Street adaptive signals, as approved by Council through R-17-39.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CONWAY, ARKANSAS THAT:

Section 1. The City of Conway shall accept the proposal from and enter into an agreement with Temple in the amount of \$478,677.

Section 2. All resolutions in conflict herewith are repealed to the extent of the conflict.
