Minority Business Development Agency Capital Readiness Program Overview

The MBDA Capital Readiness Program is designed to help close the entrepreneurship gap between socially and economically disadvantaged individuals (SEDI) and non-SEDI. This notice requests applications from qualified organizations that have the expertise to provide technical assistance for entrepreneurs starting or scaling their businesses who are seeking various forms of capital. Specifically, MBDA expects this Program to serve SEDI-owned businesses that are applying, have previously applied, or plan to apply to an SSBCI capital program or other government program that supports small businesses.

The proposed activities may resemble the service models of incubators (focusing on early-stage technical assistance for new entrepreneurs) or accelerators (providing emerging-stage technical assistance to businesses ready to expand or scale), or provide a combination of both service models.

The program is focused on Capacity Building, Access to Capital, and Access to Networks for SEDI groups.

Each eligible applicant shall provide a non-Federal match ranging from 10% to 25% depending on the award amount for the entire 4 year program period.

Funding will be distributed beginning July 1, 2023 and will continue for up to 4 years in 12 month increments.

The Conductor is preparing an application to bolster our reach and services provided out of the Arnold Innovation Center specifically focusing on BIPOC, women, and rural entrepreneurs providing technical assistance and a mini accelerator program for new businesses to bridge the gap until they're eligible for our 10X Growth Accelerator. State, local, and federal entities are not eligible to apply for these grant funds, but can act as match partners.

Our internal deadline is February 24, 2023 for submission of our application.

Because you failed or refused to remove, abate, or eliminate certain conditions on the aforementioned real property in the City of Conway, after having been given seven (7) days notice in writing to do so, the City of Conway was forced to undertake the cleanup of this property to bring it within compliance of the Conway Municipal Code.

The City of Conway is requesting payment for all costs expended in correcting said condition. If after thirty (30) days from the receipt of this letter notifying you of the cost to correct said condition, such payment has not been remitted to the City, the City has the authority to file a lien against real estate property for the cost expended after City Council approval.

At its **February 14, 2023 Meeting**, 6:30 p.m. located at 1111 Main Street, the City Council will conduct a public hearing on three items:

- 1. Consideration of the cost of the clean-up of your real property.
- 2. Consideration of placing a lien on your real property for this amount.
- 3. Consideration of certifying this amount determined at the hearing, plus a ten percent (10%) penalty for collection & filing fees, to the Tax Collector of Faulkner County to be placed on the tax books as delinquent taxes and collected accordingly.

A RESOLUTION APROVING THE CITY TO APPLY FOR GRANT FUNDS FROM THE FEDERAL AVIATION ADMINISTRATION AND ACCEPTING THE LOWEST BID FOR THE RUNWAY 4-22 REHABILITATION PROJECT FOR THE CONWAY AIRPORT; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES

Whereas, the Conway City Council previously approved the Conway Regional Airport five year capital improvement plan and professional engineering and support services for the Runway 4-22 Rehabilitation Project through R-22-47; and

Whereas, the City of Conway seeks Council approval to apply for a Federal Aviation Administration (FAA) AIP grant in the amount of \$58,400 to cover professional services for the project stated above. This grant funding will consist of \$52,560 federal share and \$5,840 state share and will be received at the end of the project; and

Whereas, the City seeks Council approval to apply for a FAA BIL grant in the total amount of \$346,500 to cover construction and project advertisement. This grant funding will consist of \$311,850 federal share and \$34,650 state share and will be received at the end of the project; and

Whereas, the City solicited bids for this project and received a total of five bids from: Scodeller Construction, GDS, LLC, Metro Construction Services, LLC, Eagle Rock Contracting and Weaver-Bailey Contractors. The lowest bid submitted was from Scodeller Construction in the amount of \$345,656.50. The City requests Council approval to enter into a contract with Scodeller Construction for the bid amount.


NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CONWAY, ARKANSAS THAT:

A RESOLUTION ALLOWING THE CITY TO FOLLOW COOPERATIVE PROCUREMENT CONTRACTS FOR THE PURCHASE AND INSTALLATION OF FIELD LIGHTING FOR THE CONWAY SOCCER COMPLEX PROJECT; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES

Whereas, the City of Conway approved a rededication of the Advertising and Promotion bond to build a new soccer complex that would include ten lighted fields, a concessions building, bathrooms, office space, seating, trails; and

Whereas, after a complete detailed scope of this project, it would be most beneficial for the City to enter into separate agreements for the purchase and installation of field lighting; and

Whereas, the City request that Council allow the City to use the Sourcewell Contract 071619-MSL Contract with Musco Lighting Company to purchase field lighting for an amount not to exceed \$883,913.00 and

Whereas, the City request Council allow the City to use the TIPS USA Contract #200201 with Centech for installation of the field lighting for an not to exceed \$380,000.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CONWAY, ARKANSAS THAT:

Section 1. The City of Conway shall enter into an agreement with Musco Lighting Company to purchase field lighting for the Conway Soccer Complex for an amount not to exceed \$883,913.00.

AN ORDINANCE APPROPRIATING FUNDS FOR THE NON-UNIFORMED EMPLOYEES PENSION PLAN; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES

Whereas, the Non-Uniformed Employees' Pension Plan ("the Plan") underwent an actuarial valuation ("the report") as of January 1, 2022; and

Whereas, the report showed that the Plan had a funded ratio of 38.5%, meaning that the actuarial value of assets in the Plan were sufficient to cover only 38.5% of the actuarial accrued liability; and

Whereas, the report projects that in order to get the Plan 100% funded, it would take an additional approximate contribution of \$460,000 per year for the next 30 years; and

Whereas, City management agrees that to get the Plan 100% funded would be ideal, however it is not necessary to ensure the viability of the Plan in perpetuity; and

Whereas, City management instead prefers to contribute funding to the Plan on a per annum basis, depending on financial performance of the previous fiscal year; and

Whereas, fiscal year 2022 yielded above average financial performance.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE I	T ORDAINED BY THE CITY COU	INCIL OF THE CITY OF (CONWAY, ARKANSAS THAT
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Section 1. The City of Conway shall appropriate \$______ from the Fund Balance Appropriation Accounts of the City's operating funds (General, Street, Sanitation, Airport) to the Non-Uniformed Employees Pension Plan.

Section 2. All ordinances in conflict herewith are repealed to that extent of the conflict.

Section 3. That this ordinance is necessary for the protection of the public peace, health and safety, and an emergency is hereby declared to exist, and this ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and approval.
