A RESOLUTION APPROVING THE YEAR 2023 COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT BLOCK GRANT FUNDING AND BUDGET,

AUTHORIZING	THE SUBMISSION OF THE PROGRAM YEAR 2023 ACTION PLAN, AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES	
Whereas,	It is the intention of the City Council of the City of Conway to allocate Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) funds in such a manner that the maximum feasible priority is given to activities which will benefit low to moderate income families and eliminate slum and blight.	
Whereas,	there is an approximate total of \$476,652.00 for Program Year 2023 (July 1, 2023 – June 30, 2024) funds allocated to the CDBG Program for budgetary purposes, subject to change by HUD.	
NOW THEREFORE	BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CONWAY, ARKANSAS THAT:	
Section 1:	The Program Year 2023 CDBG approximate budget totaling four hundred seventy-six thousand six hundred and fifty-two dollars ($$476,652$) for budgeting purposes is hereby adopted by reference to the attached budget sheet.	
Section 2:	The in-house Affirmative Action Policy which prescribes equal opportunity policies for the recruitment, hiring, training, promoting, demotions, and termination of employees, with personnel goals revised annually.	
Section 3:	The Program Year 2023 CDBG Affirmative Action Plan is adopted to provide contractual procedures with regard to equal opportunity personnel policies on the part of CDBG project contractors.	
Section 4:	The Fair Housing Program/Policy of the City of Conway to affirmatively further Fair Housing practices in the sale, lease, or rental of housing and to prevent discrimination on the basis of race, color, religion, national origin, sex, disability, or familial status and to provide a procedure and Fair Housing Officer to assist and educate the public on their rights and procedures available to have complaints reviewed, investigated and resolved.	
Section 5:	The Director of Community Development is authorized to prepare and submit the 2023 Action Plan to carry out the activities/projects identified in the 5-Year Consolidated Plan to the U. S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD) for review and approval. Once the approval by HUD has occurred, the City Council approval, Mayor is authorized to execute contracts, his signature being attested by the City Clerk, with the agencies identified in the Community Development Department Budget as application numbers to undertake the activities/projects in the Action Plan.	
Section 6:	All approved agencies of CDBG funds will use the city's procurement procedures for any services or contract.

Five Year objectives:

Objectives with strategies in brief:

1. Repair and maintain streets and sidewalks.

Assess the city's streets and sidewalks and fund according to need.

2. Enhance the capacity of the City's drainage and stormwater runoff systems.

Assess drainage, storm, water, and sewer systems and allow funding for public improvements and a combination of loans and grants for private improvements.

- 3. Increase the supply of affordable, suitable housing.
 - a. Work with area non-profit partners to create, rehab, and replace affordable housing
 - b. Create a housing strategy that focuses on the homeless

 - a. Establish a microenterprise development program.
 - b. Grants/Loans to for profit-businesses, particularly businesses that focus on broadband/internet access and technology (see 24 CFR 570.203 (b).

Whereas, in accordance with Ark. Code Ann. § 14-54-901, the City of Conway has corrected conditions existing on 1612 Hardy St., within the City of Conway and is entitled to compensation pursuant to Ark. Code § 14-54-904: and

Whereas, State law also provides for a lien against the subject property, with the amount of lien to be determined by the City Council at a hearing held after the notice to the owner thereof by certified mail with said amount \$115.85 (\$91.68 + Penalty \$9.17 + filing fee \$15.00) to be thereafter certified to the Faulkner County Tax Collector; and

Whereas, a hearing for the purpose of determine such lien has been set for March 14, 2022 in order to allow for service of the attached notice of same upon the listed property owners, by certified or publication as is necessary.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the City Council of the City of Conway, Arkansas that:

Section 1: That after said public hearing the amount listed above is hereby certified and is to be forwarded to the Faulkner County Tax Collector and Assessor by the City of Conway.

Section 2: That this Resolution shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and approval.

Because you failed or refused to remove, abate, or eliminate certain conditions on the aforementioned real property in the City of Conway, after having been given seven (7) days notice in writing to do so, the City of Conway was forced to undertake the cleanup of this property to bring it within compliance of the Conway Municipal Code.

The City of Conway is requesting payment for all costs expended in correcting said condition. - 1. Consideration of the cost of the clean-up of your real property.
- 2. Consideration of placing a lien on your real property for this amount.
- 3. Consideration of certifying this amount determined at the hearing, plus a ten percent (10%) penalty for collection & filing fees, to the Tax Collector of Faulkner County to be placed on the tax books as delinquent taxes and collected accordingly.

AN ORDINANCE APPROPRIATING FUNDS AND APPROVING CHANGE ORDER #1 AND AMENDMENT #1 FOR POMPE PARK PHASE II FOR CONWAY PARKS & RECREATION; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES

Whereas, City Council approved Crafton Tull & Associates for the Pompe Park project on November 9th, 2021;

Whereas, the City solicited bids for the construction of Pompe Park (Phase I) to include the Veteran's Plaza on July 13th, 2022, with JCI selected as the lower bidder on this project; and

Whereas, Phase II of Pompe Park will include the completion of the project; and

Whereas, the City of Conway has funds available in the A&P Fund and would like to appropriate funds for this project.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CONWAY, ARKANSAS THAT:

Section 1. The City of Conway shall approve change order #1 for Pompe Park Phase II in the amount of \$817,392 for JCI Construction and amendment #2 for Crafton Tull in the amount of \$15,000 and allow the Mayor to enter into an agreement and execute all documents associated with the Pompe Park/Veteran's Plaza Project Phase II.

Section 2. The City of Conway shall appropriate \$832,392 from the A&P Fund Balance Appropriation account 252-000-4900 into the A&P CIP - Misc account 252-165-5990.

Section 3. All ordinances in conflict herewith are repealed to the extent of the conflict.
