Section A – Project Overview:

1. Scope:

The City wishes to create an Active Pocket Park at property off Court Street and in an Alleyway off of Chestnut in Conway. The design will be based on the conceptual plan previously provided to the City of Conway by MCE and a survey to be provided by the City of Conway. The park will include site design, landscape and irrigation design for 3 distinct spaces including the Main Park, Corridor and Alley Park. Some of the items to be included will be the following:

- Court Street Market for potential vendor space along Court Street
- Café Tables in the middle just south of the food truck lane or take out from local restaurants
- Active lawn for movies in the park, and space to play
- Alleyway concepts off of Chestnut will carry a similar pattern as the Main Park area along with benches, seating areas, and planting buffers and possibly the utilization of the northern wall as a mural wall
- Electrical will be included for lighting and possible food and other vendors

AN ORDINANCE ACCEPTING GRANT PROCEEDS AWARDED TO THE CONWAY FIRE DEPARTMENT BOMB SQUAD, WAIVING THE COMPETITIVE BIDS PROCESS, AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES:

Whereas, Conway Fire Department has been awarded two grants. One in the amount of \$76,204 (Community Preparedness) and one in the amount of \$301,976 (Bomb), both by the Arkansas Department of Emergency Management (ADEM) as the State Administrative Agency (SAA) for the Homeland Security Grant Program (HSGP) from the Department of Homeland Security Federal Emergency Management Agency (DHS FEMA) as a recipient for the FY23 Homeland Security Grant Program; and

Whereas, the Conway Fire Department Bomb Squad requests acceptance of these grants in order to purchase equipment and training.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CONWAY, ARKANSAS THAT:

Section 1. The City of Conway shall budget grant funds of \$378,180 in the Federal Grant Fund Revenue Account (399.000.4750) and transfer \$242,280 into the Grant Machinery and Equipment expense account (399.131.5910); \$80,000 in the Grant Vehicles expense account (399-131-5920), \$25,400 into the Grant Conferences expense account (399-131-5750), and \$30,500 into the Grant Travel expense account (399.131.5910).

Section 2. The City of Conway hereby approves waiving the competitive bid requirement and will utilize TWB Designs as a sole source vendor for the ammo burner upgrade (\$30,000).

Section 3. All ordinances in conflict herewith are repealed to the extent of the conflict.

AN ORDINANCE APPROPRIATING FUNDS FOR A FINANCE AGREEMENT MADE IN 2022 FOR THE PURCHASE OF ONE RESCUE PUMPER UNIT AND ONE PUMPER UNIT; DECLARING AN EMERGENCY; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES

Whereas Conway City Council previously approved the purchase of one rescue pumper unit and one pumper unit through O-22-108, and;

Whereas, The Conway Fire Department is responsible for yearly payments. \$250,000 is funded by pay as you go, the remainder of \$128,525 is due from the general fund and was not included in the 2024 budget, as previously approved.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CONWAY, ARKANSAS THAT:

- **Section 1**. The City of Conway shall appropriate \$128,525 from the General Fund Balance Appropriation account 001.119.4900 into the Fire Department Vehicles Account 001.131.5920.
- **Section 2.** This ordinance is necessary for the protection of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, and this ordinance shall be in full force and effort from and after its passage and approval.
 - **Section 3.** All ordinances in conflict herewith are repealed to that extent of the conflict.
