At its meeting the Conway City Council took the following actions:

Ordinances Passed:

- Ordinance {O-08-79} changing the street name of Rea Drive to Woodside Drive. **Vote 7-0 w/ Alderman Whitmore not present.**
- Ordinance {O-08-80} accepting grant proceeds in the amount of \$9,960 from the Arkansas Forestry Commission. **Vote 7-0**
- Ordinance {O-08-81} appropriating funds in the amount of \$94,891 to perform engineering services to revise and update plans for the Salem Road Railroad Overpass. **Vote 7-0**
- Ordinance {O-08-83} appropriating funds in the amount of \$10,900 for District Court to make improvements to the lobby area and purchase additional office equipment. **Vote 7-0**
