November 18th, 2008

At its meeting the Conway City Council took the following actions:

Ordinances Passed:

- Ordinance {O-08-136} closing the twenty foot alley located at Block 73 of Boulevard Addition. **Vote 7-0 w/ Alderman Thompson not present.**
- Ordinance {O-08-137} accepting and appropriating grant proceeds in the amount of \$52,000 received from Faulkner County Solid Waste Management District for the Sanitation Department. **Vote 7-0**
- Ordinance {O-08-138} appropriating additional funds in the amount of \$124,800 for overtime in the Conway Fire Department. **Vote 7-0**
- Ordinance {O-08-139} waiving bids to obtain competitive bids to purchase a 2009 Ford Escape Hybrid in the amount of \$27,131.52 for the Information Technology Dept. **Vote 6-1 w/ Alderman Vaught voting against (Emergency Clause passed 7-0)**
- Ordinance {O-08-140} accepting a variety of previously court ordered weapons for the CPD. **Vote 7-0**
- Ordinance {O-08-141} accepting court ordered forfeiture assets from the Circuit Court of Faulkner County. **Vote 7-0**
- Ordinance {O-08-142} appropriating funds in the amount of \$200,014 for gas and diesel for various departments for the City of Conway. **Vote 7-0**
- Ordinance {O-08-143} appropriating funds in the amount of \$163,240 for the employee appreciation bonus. **Vote 7-0**
