Ordinances Passed:

- O-15-127 Ordinance accepting the annexation of certain lands comprised of 5.00 acres located at 1720 Sturgis Road. **Vote 8-0**
- O-15-128 Ordinance approving the donation of computer hardware from District Court to different cities that is no longer use by the City. **Vote 8-0**
- O-15-129 Ordinance appropriating reimbursements funds from various entities for the CPD. **Vote 8-0**
- O-15-130 Ordinance appropriating funds in the amount of \$50,000 in overtime funds for Operation Shop Secure. **Vote 8-0**

- R-15-66 Resolution of a levy of **four-tenths (.4) mill** on the dollar be made upon the assessed valuation of all taxable real estate and personal property tax for raising special revenue for the Pension and Relief Fund for a **Policeman's Pension and Relief Fund**. **Vote 8-0**
- R-15-67 Resolution of a levy of **four-tenths (.4) mill** on the dollar be made upon the assessed valuation of all taxable real estate and personal property tax for raising special revenue for the Pension and Relief Fund for a **Fireman's Pension and Relief Fund**. **Vote 8-0**
- R-15-68 Resolution of a levy of **four-tenths (.4) mill** on the dollar be made upon the assessed valuation of all taxable real estate and personal property tax for raising special revenue for the Pension and Relief Fund for paid **Non-uniformed employees**. **Vote 8-0**
