INVITATION TO BID

The City of Conway Transportation Department is soliciting bids from qualified bidders for furnishing all labor, material, and equipment, and performing all work required for the construction of the Tyler Street Improvements in Conway, Arkansas. The work includes earthwork, cement treated reconstructed base, cold milling, asphalt inlay, minor drainage, thermoplastic pavement markings, concrete sidewalk, wheelchair access ramps, maintenance of traffic, concrete driveways, and related work for the street improvements. Project will be in two (2) phases with a separate Notice-to-Proceed for each; Tyler Street from Sena Dr. to Gatlin Park and Gatlin Park to Washington Ave. (Approx. 4.25 total miles).

Proposals shall be accompanied by a cashier's or certified check upon a national or state bank in an amount not less than five per cent (5%) of the total maximum bid price payable without recourse to City of Conway, Arkansas, or a bid bond in the same amount from a reliable surety company, as a guarantee that the Bidder will enter into a contract and execute performance and payment bonds within ten (10) days after notice of award of Contract to him. The Owner shall give the notice of award of Contract within sixty (60) days following the opening of bids.

The successful Bidder must furnish a performance bond and a separate payment bond upon the forms provided herein in the amount of one hundred percent (100%) of the contract price from an approved surety company holding a permit from the State of Arkansas to act as surety, or other surety or sureties acceptable to the Owner.

The attention of bidders is called to the fact that Act 150 of 1965 (as amended), Arkansas Statutes, states that a Contractor must be licensed by the State Licensing Board for Contractors before he may undertake work when the cost thereof in Arkansas is Twenty Thousand Dollars (\$20,000.00) or more.
