Sealed bids addressed to City of Conway will be received at the City of Conway Purchasing Office, Conway City Hall, Conway, Arkansas (1201 Oak Street, Conway, Arkansas 72032), until 10:00 am, Wednesday, September 6, 2017, then opened and publicly read aloud, for (Bid No. 2017-14) Conway Commons Electrical Work & Light Replacement Project. This project involves the installation of approximately 430 feet of electrical conduit and wiring, installation of an outdoor electrical panel, the replacement of 6 ten foot high light fixtures with 6 twenty four foot high light fixtures and related electrical work. The work is located in the Target parking lot on Elsinger Boulevard in Conway Commons Shopping Center in Conway, Arkansas.
